The Top 5 selected posters will be presented live on stage by the students.

Key Dates and Deadlines

24 SEPTEMBER

Submission

Each school with active MHFRs submits one poster capturing the programme from their perspective.

28 SEPTEMBER

Selection

1 poster selected per district by panel of experts.

30 SEPTEMBER

Revision

Final revised posters submitted. The Top 5 are chosen for the stage.

Sections to include in your Poster

1. My MHFR Journey:

How you became an MHFR, types of harms you know of that motivated you to be an MHFR

2. Insights:

No. of students who approached you, actions you took to address, how your role made a difference

3. Activities:

BuddyBox installation, assembly intro, case register, resources distributed, other awareness activities in school

4. Challenges:

Obstacles you faced in this role, how you handled them, and what you learned.

5. Our Ask:

Recommendations to the programme, your school, and to legal and technology decision-makers.

Poster Materials



The Base:

Chart paper or card. The foundation of your story.

The Medium:

Pens, markers, or paint. Use your creativity to make it stand out.

The Evidence:

Photos, drawings, or data. Optional additions to visually support your insights and activities.

Poster Dos & Don'ts



Must Include

- ✓ A clear title
- ✓ Your name, school, and district
- ✓ Your counsellor's name
- ✓ Your honest experience — that is what matters most.



Strictly Prohibited

- ✗ **NO** real names, or identifying details for any student cases.
- ✗ **NO** AI generated content. Detection will result in immediate disqualification.
